# OPPORTUNITY HIGHLIGHTS



## Renewables terminal at the Port of Geelong

A proposed 25-hectare facility to marshal and assemble offshore-wind components, using an existing deep-water berth and 12.3 m channel – targeted to be ready around 2029.



## Energy hub momentum

A renewable hydrogen refuelling station is already operating at Viva Energy's Geelong Refinery. Advanced co-processing uses feedstock from waste plastics, tyres and used cooking oil to produce low-emission fuels and recycled materials, strengthening energy security and supporting the circular economy. Geelong is also home to one of only two fuel refineries in Australia, providing nationally significant infrastructure for the energy transition.



## Research and development to commercialisation

Recycling and Clean Energy Commercialisation Hub (REACH) Deakin works with industry on recycling, clean energy and circular economy projects from the Geelong Future Economy Precinct.



## Precincts built for circular industry

The Geelong Ring Road Employment Precinct (GREP) combines suitable industrial zoning with future Class A recycled-water access for bioenergy, recycling and waste-to-fuel plants.



## Green-power access

Connection to Victoria's Renewable Energy Zones supports long-term renewable supply arrangements for manufacturers.
